COMPLAINT

1. Plaintiff is the State of Hawai'i, which brings and is entitled to bring this action through its Attorney General.

2. George Gary Peabody ("Peabody") is a resident of the Island of Molokai, County of Maui, State of Hawai'i, and is an owner of real property identified as Tax Map Key No. 5-7-001:001.

3. Defendants JOHN DOES 1-20, DOE CORPORATIONS 1-20, DOE PARTNERSHIPS 1-20, DOE ASSOCIATIONS 1-20, DOE GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES 1-20, AND DOE ENTITIES 1-20 are persons or entities who are or may be liable to the State for the relief sought herein. The State has its records and files relating to this matter in a good faith effort to ascertain the true names and identities of these parties.

4. Peabody and his wife are the owners of shoreline property in Waialua, Molokai, State of Hawai'i, identified as Tax Map Key No. (2) 5-7-001: 001.

5. In December 1998, Peabody built a shoreline structure on the seaward perimeter of his property.

6. The area where Peabody built the structure is in the conservation district.

7. Peabody was required by Haw. Rev. Stat. chapter 183C and administrative rules adopted thereunder to obtain a permit from the Board of Land and Natural Resources of the State of Hawai'i before building the structure but did not do so.

8. Peabody's actions violate Haw. Rev. Stat. chapter 183C and administrative rules adopted thereunder.

9. The Board of Land and Natural Resources of the State of Hawai'i, at its open meeting on August 27, 1999, took the following actions: 1) determined that Peabody violated Haw. Rev. Stat. chapter 183C and administrative rules adopted thereunder by failing to obtain the appropriate approvals for the construction of the shoreline structure; 2) fined Peabody \$2000 plus administrative costs of \$500; 3) ordered Peabody to pay the fine and costs within 30 days; 4) ordered Peabody to remove the shoreline structure within 60 days; 5) ordered that fines of \$2000

per day would accrue on the 61st day if the structure was not removed; and 6) authorized referral to the Department of Attorney General to take appropriate action if Peabody did not comply.

10. Peabody requested a contested case hearing with respect to the Board's action, but then voluntarily withdrew the request and dismissed the contested case hearing.

11. The Board's action is final, conclusive, unchallenged, and binding.

12. Peabody did not and has not to date paid the fine and administrative costs or removed the shoreline structure.


13. The State is entitled to a mandatory injunction directing Peabody to remove the shoreline structure.

14. The State is entitled to a judgment for the amount of the unpaid fines including administrative costs and the per diem fine to the date the shoreline structure is removed.

Wherefore the State prays:

1. For issuance of a mandatory injunction directing Peabody to remove the shoreline structure;
2. For judgment against Peabody for the amount of the unpaid fines including administrative costs and the per diem fine to the date the shoreline structure is removed; and
3. For such other and further relief as is just and proper.

And stop sending electronic notices of my case to Louie, Wynhoff and Blancaflor who are crooked attorneys persecuting me to destroy my family, take my home and my life and they are NOT a Party and have no right to copy communications between you feds and me. You Seabright et al, have no jurisdiction to dismiss my case, and you should know it is a CRIME to Obstruct Justice....YOU HAVE NO JURISDICTION.
